

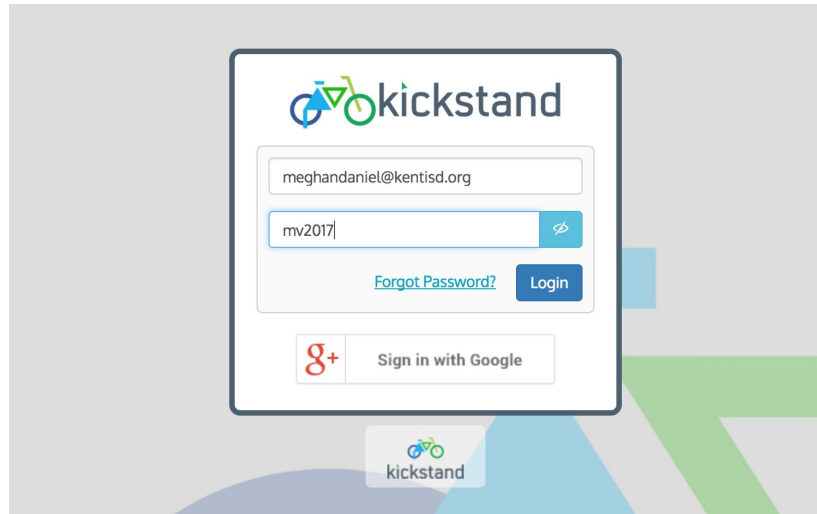
Getting Started in Your MV Liaison Course

Step 1: Welcome to Kickstand!

- Your username will be the same as your email address. Your password is mv2017.



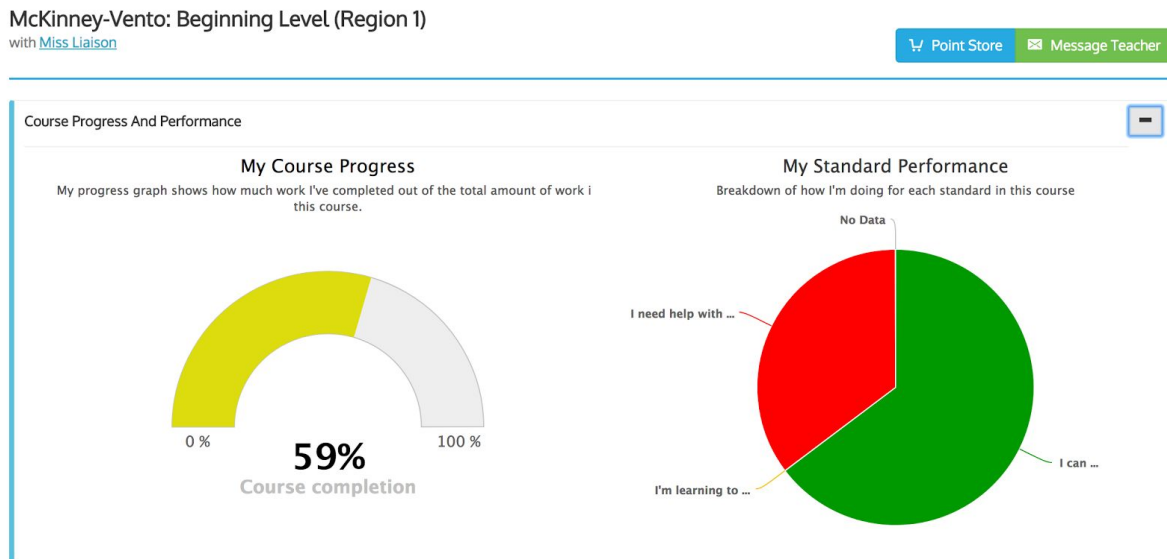
Step 3: Welcome to Your Dashboard

Step 4: Beginning Your Course
